



Before installing your joystick handle assembly kit, you must first remove the existing handle clevis end. As these are on very tight, the manufacturer recommends the following steps.

- 1. Remove the End Cap on the opposite end of the valve. You will see an allen head slot.
- Use an allen wrench to hold the spool from turning while you attempt to remove the spool clevis on the opposite end.
- If the screw comes loose on the spring end first, go ahead and remove it. Apply some Loc-tite to the screw and re-install it. Allow the Loc-tite to set and repeat Step 2.
- After you have removed the clevis end, follow the instructions included with the joystick handle kit.

Spools that have a float position will not have an allen head screw. For spools with a float position, use the following steps.

- Remove the End Cap only (DO NOT remove the entire float spool attachment). Hold the float spool attachment in place.
- Use a large flat head screw driver to keep the spool from turning while you remove the spool clevis on the opposite end. **
- After you have removed the clevis end, follow the instructions included with the joystick.
